(Please indicate the scholarship(s) for which you are applying.)

____ **Poll-Ette Founders Scholarship** *(Applicant must be between the ages of 17-22 and have attained the status of a high school senior, but not completed his or her senior year in college.)*

____ **Ed Bible Memorial Award** *(Applicant must be a high school graduate--graduating the year of which you are applying-- or a college student. Applicant must not previously have received \$500.00 or more from the Ed Bible Scholarship (top three places)*

____ **Golden Bull Achievement Award** *(Applicant must be 18 years of age by Jan. 1 of the year in which you apply. NJHA directors are ineligible to receive this award.)*

____ **Future Cattleman Scholarship** *(Applicants must be enrolled on a full-time basis in the college of their choice in a curriculum of agriculture directly related to the Hereford industry at the time the award is received.)*

____ **John Wayne Memorial Scholarship** *(Applicants must be enrolled on a full time basis in the college of their choice at the time the award is received. Applicant must be interested in pursuing a career related to agriculture, home economics or a field directly related to the Hereford industry.)*

* All applicants must be active members of the National Junior Hereford Association. Applicants may receive awards only once.

*Include a 5x7 photograph, official high school and college transcripts, a maximum of two letters of recommendation, and essay(s) applicable to the scholarship(s) for which you are applying.

Interviews will be held at the National Junior Hereford Expo in July. Finalists will be notified of their interview times. Within 30 days of the presentation of the scholarship, the recipients will write a thank you to the Ed Bible Family, sending the thank you to the Ed Bible Scholarship chairman. The chairman will then forward it to the family. The thank you should include the recipient's background, interests, and future goals and plans. Once the thank you is received, the scholarship check will be issued.

Poll-Ette Founders Scholarship

Include one paragraph describing what your involvement with Herefords has done for you. Interviews will be held at the National Junior Hereford Expo in July. Finalists will be notified of interview times. Thank you letters can be sent to the NOP or the HYFA.
