Technology is known for providing ease at the tip of a fingertip and veterinarians in Texas and surrounding states are experiencing these benefits firsthand through a new tool developed by Texas A&M AgriLife faculty.

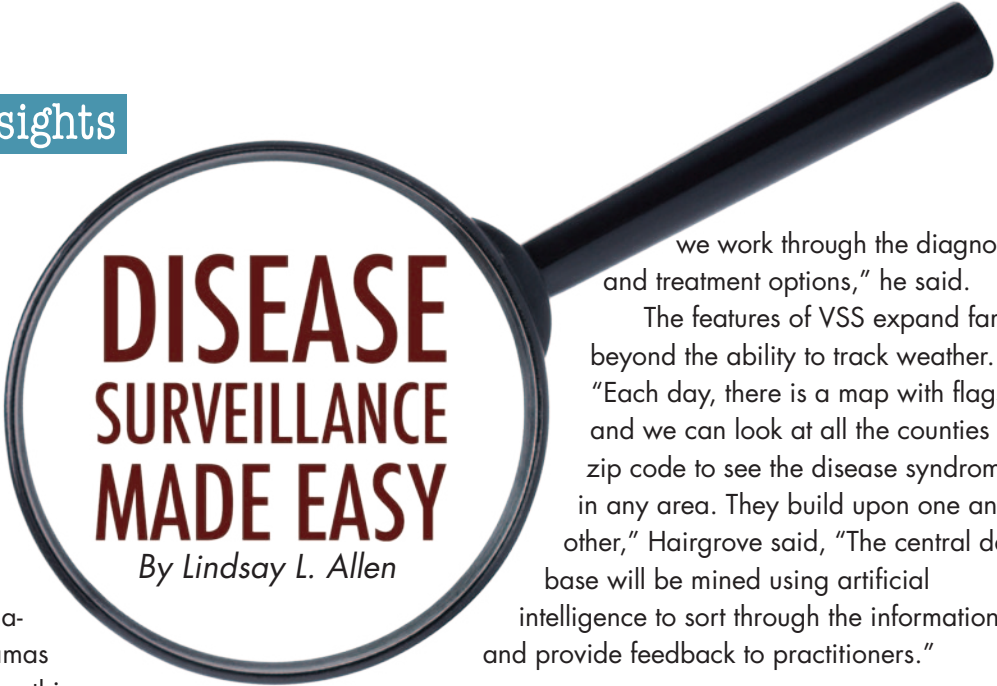
The Veterinary Syndromic Surveillance System (VSS) website and app provide veterinarians with a tool to access and input disease information for cattle, sheep, swine, horses, llamas and alpacas to a central database. From this database, they can survey patterns in their area and the larger region to help reach conclusions or talk with other veterinarians about what they are seeing in the field. VSS, still in the pilot phase, has been primarily used for the cattle industry by over 50 veterinarians and the Texas Health Commission.

Dr. Tom Hairgrove, DVM, Ph.D. Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service cattle veterinary specialist in the Texas A&M University Department of Animal Science, is leading a three-year "Improving the Sustainability of Rural Veterinarians Through Mentoring, Targeted Education, Telemedicine and Monitoring of Disease Syndromes" project, funded by a U.S. Department of Agriculture National Institute of Food and Agriculture grant and one of the goals of the grant is to provide quality continuing education in production medicine and participation in real-time disease surveillance, thereby providing practitioners, students and veterinary technicians with an increased awareness of state and regional livestock disease issues.

The VSS website and app help accomplish this goal and set veterinarians up for success, even before they head to a location.

The tool allows veterinarians in Texas, New Mexico and Arizona to enter information pertaining to their visits. The information can be entered via a smartphone and in real-time, or at a later time using the website. While the client information and exact location is protected, the issues or reason for the visit can be visible to all other veterinarians using the tool – allowing them to see trends and make connections with veterinarians working similar cases as them. Hairgrove said the tool also has the ability to track weather, which can occasionally help users reach a conclusion as well and see if the climate is a factor.

This is of special interest to Dr. Robert Conley, a veterinarian in Wilbarger County, Texas, who uses VSS and finds the value in tracking weather patterns and data. "VSS has the ability to keep up with the weather and as you enter cases into the tool, you will be able to see the average temperature or rainfall for that time period and perhaps there is a story to uncover as

we work through the diagnosis and treatment options," he said.

The features of VSS expand far beyond the ability to track weather. "Each day, there is a map with flags, and we can look at all the counties by zip code to see the disease syndromes in any area. They build upon one another," Hairgrove said, "The central database will be mined using artificial intelligence to sort through the information and provide feedback to practitioners."

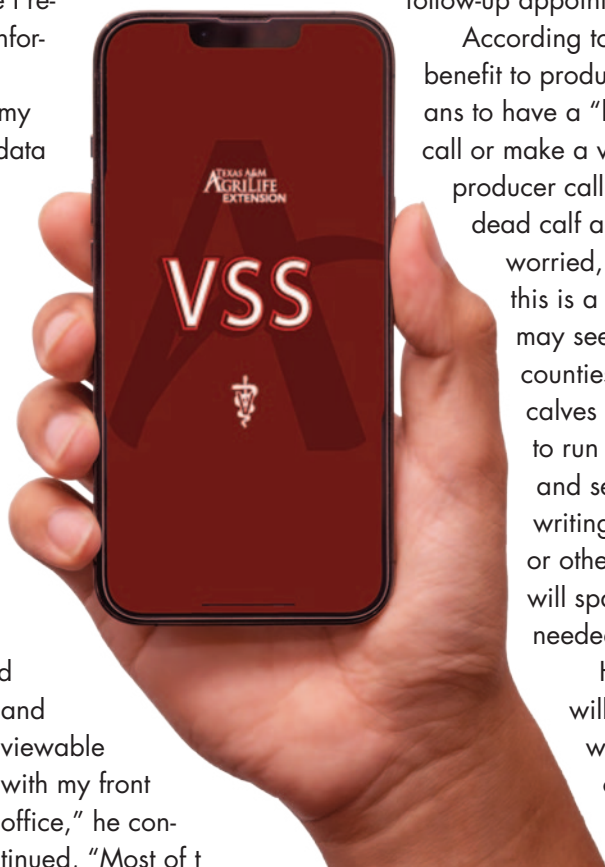

Conley also uses the tool in real time when he is making onsite visits. "The data I enter beats me back to the office and my team can start the billing process before I return. A valuable feature of this app is that information about the site and the producer is protected, which means I can use this with my front office, but also can use the high-level data that protects the client to connect and find trends with other veterinarians," he shared.

Hairgrove echoed this by saying that his team built the tool so that veterinarians can enter their notes for their own records and their front offices, but also the ability to protect confidential information in the database.

Conley pointed out that most of his visits are in rural locations where the cell signal is unreliable, but praised the tool for still allowing him to input data despite this. "Once I move to an area that has a strong cell signal, the data is then uploaded



and viewable with my front office," he continued, "Most of the ranches I visit are not favorable when it comes to cell signal, but I'm not slowed down by this fact and am still able to use this technology even without cell signal!"

Debby Perry, Research Compliance Officer for the Texas A&M University Department of Animal Science and doctorate student who has been involved in developing the app, added that for the individual veterinarian, the benefit lies

in the electronic record keeping verses pen and paper method. "He or she can do everything chute side and make notes about follow-up appointments, diagnosis and treatment.

According to Conley, this tool provides a real benefit to producers because it allows veterinarians to have a "heads up" before they receive a call or make a visit to an operation. "When a producer calls and says they have found a dead calf and want to know if they should be worried, I can utilize the app and see if this is a problem elsewhere in our area. I may see that another veterinarian three counties over is also reporting dead calves in the tool, which now causes me to run diagnostics on my client's calf and see if I can find the story versus writing off one dead calf due to weather or other conditions," he said, "This tool will spark us to dig deeper when needed."

Hairgrove pointed out that the tool will help with natural disasters as well. "Every time we have a hurricane, we have to back track and think through the diseases that arises following this natural disaster, but the tool will allow

us to enter information after each disaster and refer back to it as needed," he said, "We can now be proactive and quicker and more agile in our practice because of the historical data VSS can house."

Perry pointed out that VSS also has the capability of hosting team meetings so that users can collaborate and have brainstorming sessions as trends arise, or veterinarians in a region can reach out to other veterinarians experiencing similar issues.

Realizing that change and new technology is not quickly adopted, Hairgrove is hoping that by introducing VSS to veterinarian students, particularly those in the field during an internship, they will adopt the tool and implement it going forward in their practice to help spread the use across the state(s).

"It's so easy to use. It takes about two minutes to get used to and then you just start filling in the information you want to enter – it's a breeze!" Conley said.

As VSS continues to roll out and be adopted by more and more veterinarians, the ability to make more and stronger connections will only continue to increase amongst veterinarians.

The History and Impact of Hereford Cattle in Texas

The success of the Hereford cattle breed in Texas was instrumental in the disappearance of longhorn cattle as a major range breed. Herefords also proved better adapted to the conditions of the open range than were shorthorn cattle, and eventually replaced that breed, also, as the dominant cattle breed in Texas. Hereford cattle likely originated from wild, aboriginal animals known to have been present in the Herefordshire area of West England as early as the fifth century. There are several different stories of how these cattle developed into the modern breed of Herefords. One version has it that the wild cattle crossed with red animals from Yorkshire and white-faced animals from Holland. It is also possible that white Welsh cattle were bred with Herefordshire stock. The cross produced a superior beast of burden that

fattened at an early age and had excellent milk capacity. Herefords as a distinct breed with the basic distinguishing characteristics of today were established by the last quarter of the 1700s. The modern Hereford is colored dark red to red-yellow, with a white face, crest, dewlap, and underline. Herefords with white flanks and white markings below the knees and hocks are also common. Mature males may weigh up to 1,800 pounds, while mature females may weigh around 1,200. The first Herefords were

introduced to America by Henry Clay in 1817, when he brought a cow, a heifer, and a young bull to his Kentucky farm. They were bred with shorthorn cattle to avoid inbreeding, and in subsequent generations, the Hereford characteristics were gradually lost. The first breeding herd was established in New York when William H. Sotham imported 22 animals. In 1876, some of the first Herefords to arrive in Texas were brought in by the E. F. and William S. Ikard brothers of Henrietta, Texas. They purchased ten animals at the Philadelphia Centennial Exposition, shipped them by rail to Denison, and then trailed them to Henrietta. Unfortunately, all but one of

these cattle died. The Ikard brothers bought others, however, including some animals from the royal herd that bore the brand of Queen Victoria. Also in 1876, J. F. Brady of Houston bought a bull from William Powell of Beecher, Illinois.

Later, Charles Goodnight of the JA Ranch of West Texas attempted to breed Durham (shorthorn) cattle but found that they were not suited to the environment and instead switched to Herefords. He introduced Herefords into the Panhandle in 1883, when he placed twenty registered bulls on the JA Ranch. In 1884, he imported forty bulls from Herefordshire. He encouraged other ranchers to experiment in crossbreeding, and between 1882 and 1888, several thousand Hereford bulls were trailed from Dodge City to the Panhandle. In 1897, Christopher Columbus Slaughter began to stock his holdings

with purebred Herefords. About 1900, Robert J. Kleberg experimented with Hereford bulls on the King Ranch in South Texas; these experiments were instrumental in eradicating the menace of Texas fever. In the late 1890s, Warren Gammon and a small group of midwestern Hereford breeders developed the polled (hornless) Hereford, beginning with 13 animals that had mutated to be naturally hornless. These breeders formed the American Polled Hereford Cattle Club in 1900. In 1947, this group changed its name to

the American Polled Hereford Association; its headquarters were in Kansas City, Missouri. In the early 1990s, the Texas Polled Hereford Association headquarters was in Rio Vista, Texas. At that time, there were about 180 polled-Hereford breeders in Texas. The American Hereford Breeders Association was formed in Chicago in 1881 for the purpose of registering purebred Hereford cattle. It became the American Hereford Association in 1934, with headquarters in Kansas City. The Texas Hereford Association originated in San Antonio during the International Livestock Exposition in 1899. In the early 1990s, there were about 150 Hereford breeders in Texas.

- 2 pounds ground beef, browned and drained (we always use Hereford Beef from our ranch)
- 1 white onion chopped fine
- 1 package Knorr Spanish Rice - 5.6 ounce package
- 2 teaspoons Tony Chachere's Creole Cajun Seasoning (optional) & if not, add salt & pepper to taste, & 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 4 cups water
- 1 - 10-ounce can Rotel Mexican Style Tomatoes with Lime & Cilantro
- 8 green or assorted red or orange bell peppers, coated & parboiled (boiled for 5 - 10 minutes until slightly softened & allowed to drain and dry)
- 1/2 cup Velveeta Shredded or fresh grated cheddar cheese

Toppings: grated cheese that melts easily (Kraft's Meximelt grated cheese blend), sliced black olives, additional green onions, chopped, Salsa, or what we call in Texas - hot sauce (what you eat with tortilla chips), chopped cilantro.

Instructions

- Prepare bell peppers by cutting off the tops and removing the inner core and seeds. Save the tops of bell peppers and add them once chopped when you brown the ground beef later in this recipe.
- Place bell peppers in a large pot of water and bring to a boil for five to 10 minutes. You'll want peppers soft, but not cooked through. Drain bell peppers and place them in a lightly greased oven-safe dish that will house them tightly. You do not want your bell peppers to tip over, so stack the bell peppers close together,
 - Brown ground beef and chopped onion, 1/2 cup chopped bell pepper from the tops, and then drain all leftover grease/liquid.

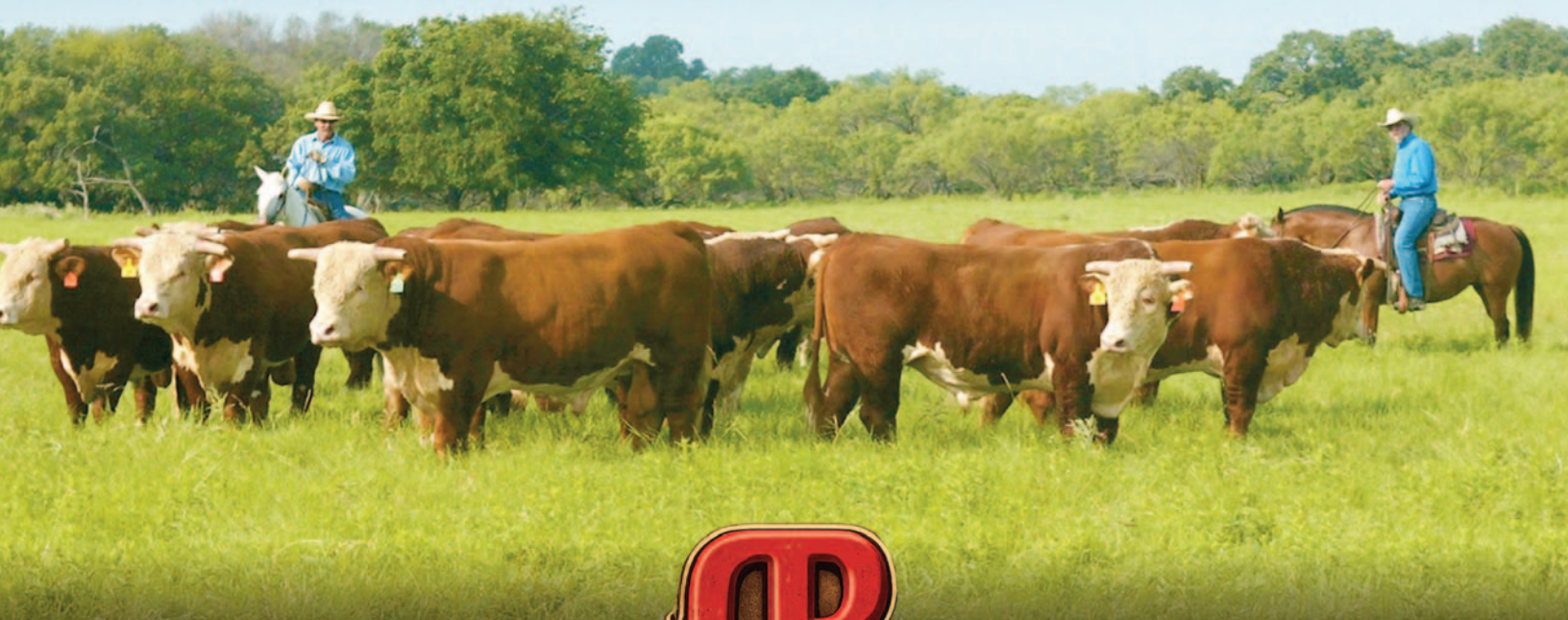
