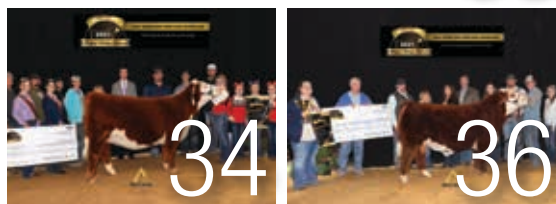


THA Annual Meeting Update

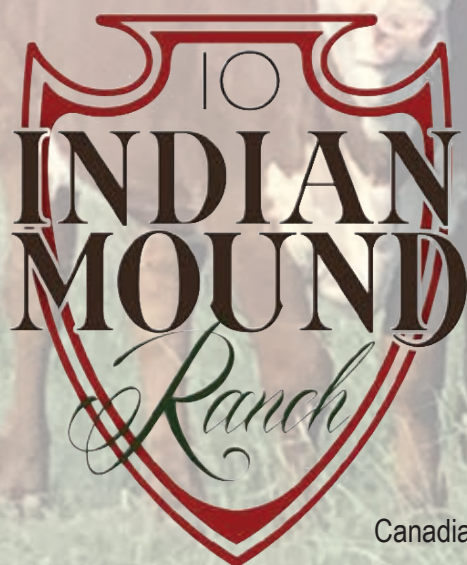

Now when analyzing this bull, you will also note that like his sire 710E, he should be a terrific heifer bull. We will be calving heifers bred to him in the Spring and are excited to see the calves. Finally, for those of you who like studying pedigrees, you will have fun with this one that is loaded with both Hereford and Indian Mound history!

Carl and Pat Schlinke

Pat and Carl Schlinke feel privileged to have been selected to receive an Honorary Membership in The Texas Hereford Association. We have been inseparable for the past 70 years, 68 of which we have been married. We are blessed with 3 children, Brit 66, Carmen 62, and John 58, all architects. The five of us formed a partnership in 1980 and have operated the Schlinke Dry Creek Ranch LP since inheriting it from Carl's family in 1975. Our lives have been filled with many memorable experiences and challenging encounters. Carl attended school at Arden, TX until the school dwindled to 7 students scattered over 11 grades. In 1945, at the age of 13, Carl was enrolled at Culver Military Academy where he graduated high school in 1949. Pat was raised on a stock farm near Andice, TX and attended elementary school in Florence. In 1946 she began high school in Georgetown while living alone during the week and returning home over the weekends. While Pat was attending Southwestern University in Georgetown she and Carl met on a blind date and the everlasting romance began. Carl soon discovered, while enrolled at Texas A & M, and after living 5 years in an all-male environment, 100 miles commuting to Georgetown was not conducive to good study habits; therefore, they decided to marry in January 1952 and begin an uncharted life. The first five

years were especially challenging since the "Drought of the '50s" eliminated their chances of returning to the ranch in Arden and necessitated the sale of their flock of 200 commercial Rambouillet ewes. Pat went to work at Bryan Air Force Base while Carl got a part-time job with the US Postal Service while pursuing a double degree in Animal Husbandry and Animal Science. 1954 was a bountiful year: Carl graduated and received his commission in the US Army, at the same time receiving admission to A & M College of Veterinary Medicine. (One must remember that the State of Texas, in its infinite wisdom, would not allow women to enroll at A & M

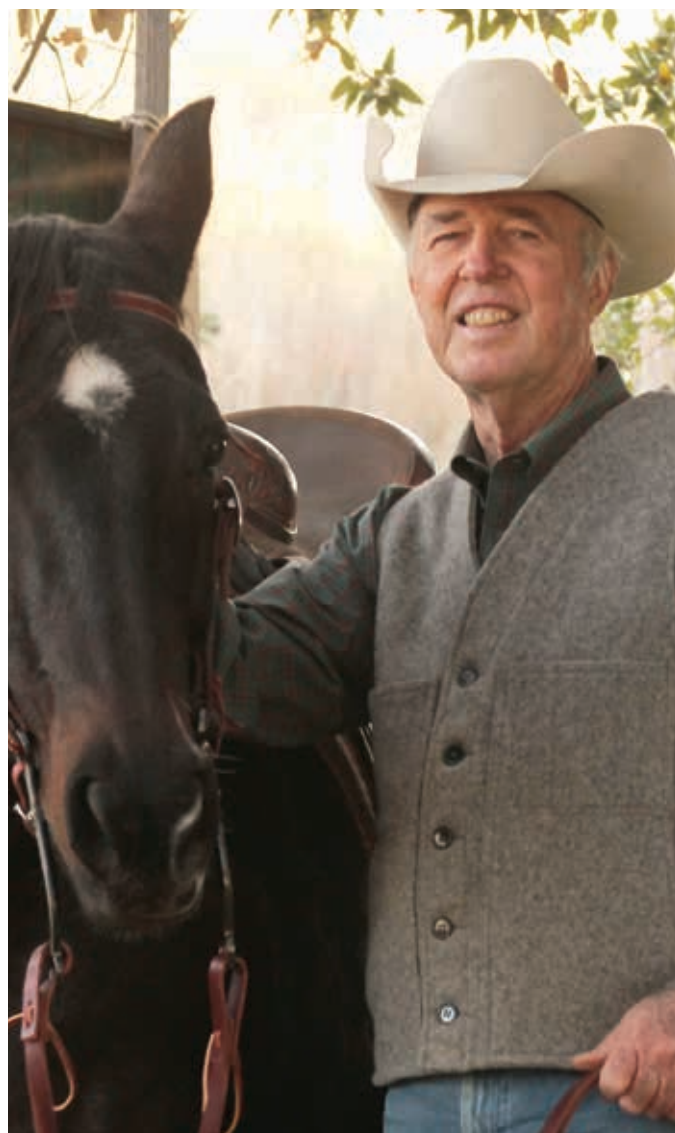
thereby preventing Pat from pursuing her degree in Journalism.) Upon graduating Veterinary School in 1958, they departed College Station as a family of four and began military service in the US Army Veterinary Corps.

1958 terminated the first one-third of their lives pursuing "book-learning" education and began, what turned out to be, their first career of 30 years serving in the military. Carl and Pat started out planning to serve his four-year military obligation and return to ranching in West Texas. However, unforeseen "doors opened" and they chose to remain with the Army finding it offered wonderful opportunities to raise a family, even while moving 17 times. The family enjoyed overseas assignments in Alaska, Germany, and Thailand plus assignments in the States such as West Point, Fort Bragg, Fort Sam Houston, and The Presidio of San Francisco. During this period, Carl was able to perform his duties without "playing politics", receive promotions on schedule, and retired with the rank of Colonel. In 1982, Pat moved to the Dry Creek ranch, while Carl continued to serve at Fort Sam Houston, and calve-out their beginning herd of 40 first-calf registered Herefords. Thanks to several wonderful Hereford breeders, i.e. Fred Case, Norman Kreig, and Doug Bennett, she was able to get 40 live calves on the ground, weaned at seven months, culled, and those

selected for retention placed on a growth/conditioning ration. During the following three years, while Carl continued his assignment at Fort Sam, Pat supervised the installation of 4+ miles of water lines for livestock watering, the building of two concrete stock tanks and 6 water troughs, the construction of 2 miles of cross-fencing, and the design and building of a complete set of livestock working pens for both sheep and cattle. Carl came on weekends, when work permitted, to check on Pat and her projects, never having to make any changes. Per usual, Pat was irreplaceable and gained the equivalent of a PHD in ranch and range management through her devotion to their cattle and stewardship to the ranch.

Our second career and 38 memorable years began in 1982 when we became members of the Texas Hereford Association. We have learned a lot and enjoyed knowing many wonderful Hereford breeders scattered over Texas, Kansas, North Dakota, Montana, and Oregon. We feel people in agriculture are unique, honest, hard-working, and often pillars of the community of which people in the Hereford industry are no exception. Pat and Carl survived the drought year of 2000, sold our initial herd of registered Hereford cattle and premier commercial Rambouillet sheep, and then bought back quality registered cattle in 2006 in the “pursuit of excellence”, which is our ranch motto. During the five years the ranch lay fallow, Carl grubbed the entire ranch of mesquite and cedar and re-seeded the tillable land with seven species of improved grasses. Also, during this time, the two of them, using a Polaris Ranger, hand sprayed over 2600 acres for prickly pear, young cedar and mesquite. The last 18 years have been the most rewarding in that we could afford to improve the genetics of our cattle through purchases made with Mill Creek, Jamison, Stuber, and Churchill Hereford cattle. When our family decided in 2017 to sell our cattle and lease the ranch, we experienced the most exceptional answer to a prayer revelation by being able to sell the entire herd to our neighbor, the OH Triangle ranch owned by AA Sugg estate and operated by Robin Sugg along with her niece and husband, Samantha and Ryan Akers. They have a great foundation herd of registered Hereford on which to build even better through “The Pursuit of Excellence”. We feel confident the Texas Hereford Association with its wealth of outstanding breeders will continue to support the OH Triangle ranch management team and assist them in growing their registered herd to become premier Hereford breeders in the American Hereford Association. Family roots run deep at GKB Cattle in Waxahachie, Texas. Everyone is treated like family when they drive down the lane. Cow families are also important. Gary and Kathy Buchholz both have a cattle background and feel that it is important to honor the cow families that have built their herd through the years. "We truly believe in cow families here and probably have more 10- to 12-year-old cows in our embryo program than we do younger cows," Gary says. "If they can do their job at that age, they are worth having around." When the Buchholzes select replacements in the Hereford herd, longevity is very important. Heifers are selected on individual phenotype, but genotype plays a big part in making sure they are the "keeping kind" also.

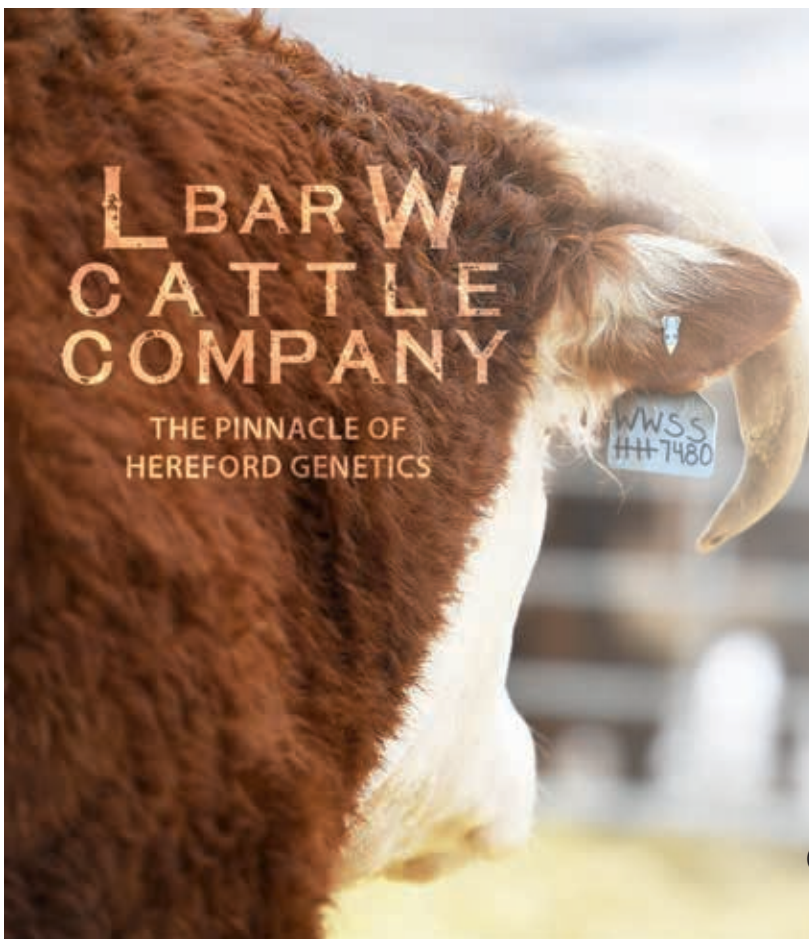
Gary's beginning in the cattle business was when he was in high school. While he wanted to buy a show heifer, his dad thought it would be a better idea for him to get a bank loan to purchase 25 Angus cows. "While it wasn't what I wanted to do at the time, I now realize it was the right thing because I learned so much about raising cattle from that experience," he says. Gary's family moved to Texas from Illinois when he was 2 years old, as business brought them to the area. His father

managed a grain elevator at the time. His family continues to have a grain elevator and feed business, along with some farm ground. The history of the Muleshoe Ranch begins in the late 1870's when Henry Black brought his family from the Red River area of Texas to Bufford Creek on the Clear Fork of the Brazos River in Stephens County.

Henry's son, Will Black, chose ranching with his brother Jack over the office job his father had trained him for. His love of the outdoors, caring for animals and desire to steward the land drove him from the office environment. According to family lore, he went to work at the bank after returning from his college days at TCU; stayed 3 hours and left his father a note, "Gone to the ranch!"

Will married Etta Sayle in 1897. A dedicated family man, it was only his devotion to his daughters Sybil and Kathryn that persuaded him to move into town for their education, riding back to the ranch for its daily demands.

Their oldest daughter Sybil married B.H. Trammell in 1923. Working alongside his father-in-law, B.H. suggested adding registered Hereford bulls to the cowherd. Those genetics began a multigenerational love for those white faced cows.

B.H. also saw it as his responsibility to begin training his daughter Patricia to take over the ranch one day as she was the only grandchild of Will and Etta Black. Patty

and Howard Swanson would take the reins at the death of B.H. in 1964.

Howard's love of numbers and making good business decisions led him to make a thorough study of the American Hereford Associations' TPR program, pedigrees and

the beginning of EPD's as a basis of breeding decisions. Their daughters, Mya and Lisa began showing Hereford heifers to begin learning the cattle industry after moving to live at the ranch in 1962.

Those ladies enthusiastically brought women to a new level of investment into the family farms and Texas Hereford industry. Howard was later asked to lead THA as President of the organization in 1992.

When Lisa and Tom Echols took over management of the ranch in 1990, Lisa's years showing cattle would prove to be immensely valuable. Tom brought his attention-to-detail

and his veterinary knowledge to the ranch as he studied breed genetics in both Angus and Hereford cattle to improve the overall quality of the herd. Finding ways to leave the ranchland in a better condition than he found it through better stewardship of the range has been extremely important to our ranching strategy.

As their kids Lauren and Will started to show cattle, Tom began to utilize artificial insemination and embryo transfer to improve the show string. These genetic improvements led to some proud moments for our family with Herefords at the halter. Knowing the value of commercial as well as registered cattle, our family has always loved the Commercial Heifer Show and Sale in Fort Worth; winning grand champions: Hereford pen in 1989, and 1997; Black Baldie pen in 2009.

The 5th and 6th generations on the ranch served the Hereford industry in many ways. Tom served as THA president 2000-2002, Lisa Texas Hereford Auxiliary 1999-2001. Following in her footsteps, Will and Lauren both served on the TJHA board. Lauren went on

to represent Texas on the NJHA Board from 2001-2004, served on the National Hereford Women Board from 2011-2014 and also led the Texas Hereford Auxiliary from 2017-2019.

Will married his wife Jami in 2015 and they have two boys, Liam and Oliver. Lauren married James Decker in 2016 and they have two girls, Miriam and Ruth. As they look to the future and how to raise up the 7th generation, the operation continues to evolve. Currently, the big kiddos love waving their flags at the cows and saying “shoo shoo,” but we know they’ll be helping before too long.

Each spring we host a Range Ready Sale at the ranch. While it started, in 2008, with just bulls, we have added in some replacement females to the sale and they’ve been a great addition to the turnout on sale day.

Before the pandemic, we were raising animals to butcher and sell to local consumers, as B.E.S.T. Beef, but as meat shortages occurred in 2020, sales really began to skyrocket. Now, we are marketing our beef to customers in our hometown and in the Houston area where Jami and Will make

their home, with plans for statewide distribution.

In addition to the cattle, stewardship of our wildlife who make their home on the ranch is an important part of the operation. Tom has diligently managed the whitetail deer and Rio Grande turkey populations and we have additionally been pleased to see a modest return of the population of Bobwhite quail in the area. Though the wild hog population can be a menace, we have found a way to manage our population while benefiting the Wounded Warrior Project. Each February veterans wounded in the line of duty have the opportunity to enjoy themselves while hunting the invasive species.

The love of the land, honesty and loyalty are values that have been passed down from generation to generation. As we look to the horizon over the old oak trees, it’s hard not to be grateful for the efforts of those who came before us to forge a path for our family. We are proud of our past and look forward to what this next generation will bring forth as time moves forward. ★

4-H and FFA programs, and holds a master's degree in Land Economics. Kathy's mother was also involved in the Hereford operation and is known as the first National Intercollegiate Rodeo All-Around Cowgirl Champion in 1951. While Kathy was growing up, her mother was very involved with Hereford activities as well. The two met while attending the Fort Worth Stock Show in the late 1970s and later married in 1987. They have served as advisors to several different youth groups and are always willing to help juniors with their projects and activities. "We truly believe in the junior program. It teaches kids so much about values, work ethic and decision making, which is so important," says Kathy. Not only did Gary and Kathy both grow up in the junior programs, but they have watched their families go through the process as well. Their nieces and nephew have shown for several years and continue the family's success.

Pasture management is important at GKB, as summers can often be dry. Therefore, they keep a watchful eye on their grass and what needs to be done to improve the pastures. Their winter pasture improvement includes the planting of endophyte-free fescue grass. "It's a very hearty grass and withstands a lot of abuse, while still providing good nutrition for our cows," says Gary. Other grasses have been interseeded, as well, to extend longevity of the grasses in their pastures. These improvements have helped them go from the need of four acres per cow to the need of only one acre per cow. Hay ground provides all the hay GKB cattle uses each year for feeding cattle through the winter months. Most of the hay baled on their ground is fed each year. High cane grasses are planted in some hay fields. These grasses are high yielding — up to 10 bales per acre — and are very highly palatable. Besides being fed high-quality hay, cows are fed a 20% protein cube throughout the year. Kathy says by

feeding cows once or twice per week, it makes them easier to move between pastures and easier to round up when working them. Cattle are provided with a 27% protein tub and high-quality minerals all year.

About 60-70% of the heifers sold go to a junior exhibitor. These show heifer prospects are sold at various consignment sales. "It takes a lot of effort to do well in the showing, but if a junior is willing to make the commitment, they can become successful," says Gary. "If a junior raises their cattle our way, then we will help them with management, including ensuring they calve unassisted the first time." The Buchholzes hope their guidance will help juniors be in the black within three years of purchasing their project. They allow customers to bring back progeny to be sold in their sales. Those animals carry the GKB prefix along with the kid's prefix. Exhibiting cattle at fairs and shows across the nation has been an excellent marketing tool for GKB. However, they realize that cattle must be able to perform outside the showing. "A heifer can be a show heifer but, ultimately, they have to be a cow," says Gary. "You can collect all the blue ribbons possible, but if an animal can't produce, they aren't worth having around." GKB-bred cattle have won at national, regional, state and county levels. The success has helped GKB continue to market high quality cattle to juniors across the country. Herd bulls, including the most recent herd bull, GKB Downtown, have been shown as well, but then are turned out on cows to prove themselves. "Every cattleman wants a good dog, a good wife and a good bull. I have been fortunate to have all of those and more," says Gary.

Gary and Kathy attracted national attention 2020 when they purchased the Grand Champion Steer at the 2020 Fort Worth Stock Show for a record price of \$300,000. The steer was a home raised Polled Hereford shown by Ryder Day of Meadow, and the first time in over 30 years that a Hereford had been selected as champion. ★


