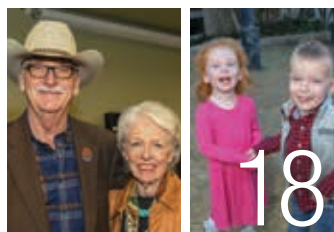

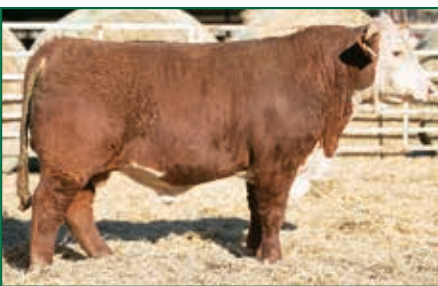

The criteria for Platinum and Gold TPR breeders will be evaluated two years prior to the award year. The following spring 2022 TPR awards reflect the spring 2020 calving season evaluation.
