



Alfred Willard "Si" McCloy

Alfred Willard "Si" McCloy, 90 of rural Hansford County, passed away on Friday, February 10, 2012 in Dumas, Texas.

Willard was born on June 11, 1921 on the family homestead, west of the Lieb community, to McLeod Wilson and Leslie (Brady) McCloy.

Willard attended school first at Centerville, then Pringle, and then graduating at Morse High School in 1938. He went on to attend Texas

Technological College (Texas Tech University) where he obtained a degree in Government in 1943.

On December 7, 1947 Willard married Beatrice Ferguson, a teacher who came to Morse from Sunnyside, Castro County, TX. In January, 1948, they moved to the present family home in Hansford County. It was here they raised their four children; Delbert, Monte, Cheryl, and Katina.

Willard was active in various college organizations, the Hutchinson County Farm Bureau, the Hansford County Farm Bureau, and the Morse Methodist Church.

Willard was elected to the Hansford County Soil and Water Conservation Board in 1962 and held all of the leadership positions, and served as President from 1988 to his retirement on December 15, 2011.

In 1943, Willard purchased bulls from Pronger Bros. of Stratford and Bob Newton of Lark. He farmed and ranched from his home base in various locations in Texas and New Mexico, and continued to implement various conservation practices in his operation until his partial retirement in 1999.






