



Attention Juniors: \$5,000 for Top Jr. in Fort Worth National Show

Funds have been committed to award \$5,000 to the top placing junior heifer and \$2,500 to second place junior heifer (if funds permit) that is exhibited at the National Hereford Show in Fort Worth. A second scholarship will be awarded if \$5,000 is exceeded. Exhibitor must be at the halter of his/her own heifer as well as be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week. To be eligible for the junior show, the ownership must be in only the exhibitors' name, no siblings or partners. See rule 12 on page 187 of

the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book. The heifer must be eligible to show for Grand Champion (no Cow/Calf). This is an incentive to encourage junior exhibitors to exhibit at the open show on February 3, 2014. To be eligible for the award, the exhibitor must enter the open show by the November 15th deadline. The exhibitor must be a member of the Texas Junior Hereford Association.

The sponsors of this award are committed to making this an annual event and hope to grow the fund to increase the prize as well as create a special belt buckle for the event. Anyone wishing to join this effort should contact Jack Chastain at the THA office. *

Chad W. Carter


Chad W. Carter of Buffalo passed away November 26, 2013 in Temple, Texas.



One cow from A. & M. College, Hazlett breeding. One from Edd Hutt Lees, Summit, Mo., by Prince Advance Mischief by Prince Domino Mischief, and nine from Banning Lewis Ranches, Colorado Springs, Colo. Our herd bull, sire of the sale cattle, son of Baron Domino 4th, Baron Domino 36th, a son of Pioneer, WHR, Pioneer 60th bought from Wyoming Hereford Ranch, Cheyenne, Wyoming.

14 bulls, 25 heifers are sired by Pioneer 60th, and two-year old heifers and 3 cows are by Baron Domino 36th. The two-year old heifers are bred to Colorado Domino 238th. The cattle men who have seen this bull say he is one of the best bulls in Oklahoma. These cattle are all rich in the blood of Prince Domino.



Auxiliarv.




