Attention Juniors: \$5,000 for Top Jr. in Fort Worth National Show

Funds have been committed to award \$5,000 to the top placing junior heifer and \$2,500 to second place junior heifer (if funds permit) that is exhibited at the National Hereford Show in Fort Worth. A second scholarship will be awarded if \$5,000 is exceeded. Exhibitor must be at the halter of his/her own heifer as well as be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week. To be eligible for the junior show, the ownership must be in only the exhibitors' name, no siblings or partners. See rule 12 on page 188 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book. The heifer must be eligible to show for Grand Champion (no Cow/Calf). This is an incentive to encour-

age junior exhibitors to exhibit at the open show on February 2, 2015. To be eligible for the award, the exhibitor must enter the open show by the November 15th deadline. The exhibitor must be a member of the Texas Junior Hereford Association.

The sponsors of this award are committed to making this an annual event and hope to grow the fund to increase the prize as well as create a special belt buckle for the event. Anyone wishing to join this effort should contact Jack Chastain at the THA office. ★

We have added Red Angus bulls and need to grow our female consignments. Our executive committee solicits your input on activities that would make you more proud to be a member of this organization. Your help, ideas and contributions are most appreciated. We need more participation from more members. Specifically we need your attendance at Hereford events. Success is generally measured by size of the crowd. Next we need more participation in advertising in our publication. More ads allow us more editorial and both will enhance Herefords and THA. We have been able to run color ads every month since January 2013 for the same rate as our old black only ads. We put our magazine on our website when we send it to the printer. We have managed to operate on a very lean budget the past few years but there are many more ways we can promote Herefords with a few more dollars in our budget.

January is a busy month, but there is something to do every month. Watch our magazine, our web site and our Facebook page for more exciting events in the planning stages for this year. Coates Ranch

Stephen, Nan, Stephanie Panozzo and Steve Wayne Coates

Coates Ranch Company was started by Pollard Hickman Coates, Sr., (Kern) and his wife Sicily in Reagan County in 1905. Kern was born in Biloxi, Mississippi, March 16, 1855, and his family moved to Fort Gates in Coryell County in Texas when he was twelve years old. Kern married Sicily Jayroe on December 19, 1878, at Buffalo Gap in Taylor County, Texas, and the judge gave the couple a section of land as a wedding gift for being the first couple married in Taylor County at its incorporation.

Kern started out his career as a cowboy following the trails of the longhorn cattle from Coryell County to the Guadalupe Mountains in New Mexico. The Coates family first saw the flat and rolling terrain that would later become Reagan County in 1885 when they traveled with a train of 17 wagons herding cattle to the Guadalupe Mountains. They camped on the banks of the big lake several miles south of where the town Big Lake now stands and rested several days, watering their stock in the lake, which was then full of water. They saw great droves of antelope and an abundance of quail and waterfowl, which came to the lake.

Mrs. Coates fell in love with the beautiful country and wanted to stop there. For several years they lived in the foothills of the Guadalupe Mountains in New Mexico. After battling with drought and near starvation, the Coates family returned to the big lake country in 1894, which Mrs. Coates had never forgotten.

Kern Coates leased University of Texas land around the big lake, and acquired a place called the Adobe, which required him purchasing some sheep with the deal. Always having considered himself a cattleman, his intention was to get rid of these sheep immediately, but some circumstances prevented his selling them. He kept the sheep, and from then on Coates

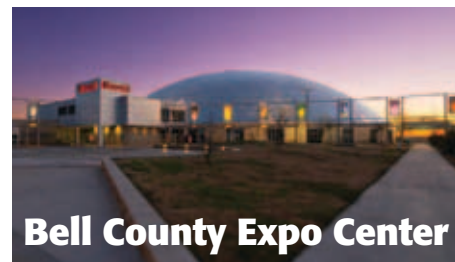
stocked both sheep and cattle, and he built the first sheep-proof fence in the county in 1914, which still stands. Kern and Sicily went on to have thirteen children, with twelve living into adulthood. Kern and his son-in-law John Allen Queen purchased the original registered herd in a partnership in 1927 from breeders in Sweetwater and Big Spring. This small group of Anxiety 4th females was and has been the only females ever purchased by the ranch. Every cow on the ranch now traces back to this original purchase.

When Kern passed away in 1929, his youngest son, P.H. Coates, Jr., took over the ranch. In 1957 P.H. Coates, Jr., purchased the registered herd from Queen, and then formed a partnership with his son Steve Wayne in 1971. P.H. Coates, Jr., passed away in 1987. In 1998, we sold all of the sheep and really concentrated on improving the cowherd and growing its size, and we now ranch in Reagan, Crockett, and Upton counties.

Steve Wayne formed a partnership with his son, Stephen, who served as President of Texas Hereford Association from 2006-2007. Stephen also practices as a board-certified gastroenterologist at Shannon Clinic in San Angelo. Steve Wayne's wife Nan helps out with keeping everyone in line, paying bills, and being a great mother. His daughter Stephanie Panozzo is married to Mike and they live in Austin where she has a successful real estate business and he has an accounting firm and races bikes, and they come home to help out when possible.

Every year we set aside resources for brush control for mesquite, cedar, blackbrush, or greasewood. Hunting has been an integral part of the business for the past 25 years including dove, quail, whitetail deer, mule deer, and varmints. We started a quarterhorse broodmare program in 2007, and now raise our own horses, which we use for working everyday. We sell between sixty to one hundred twenty bulls private treaty every year, as well as heifer groups and cow groups.

We've made many great friendships over the last 80 years, and look forward to making more. We are very humbled, honored, and thankful for this recognition this year. In our lifetime we've seen tons of changes. The big lake hasn't been full in over 30 years, oil booms and busts, sheep disappearing like dinosaurs, and the 'urbanization' of Texas—but one thing has been a constant, the true 'West Texture'—the Hereford bull and cow, and we are proud to keep that legacy going. ★

The idea of the Bell County Expo Center was driven by the need for a new facility for the Bell County Youth Fair and Livestock Show. A committee of local community leaders led the way in pushing this idea, and County Judge John Garth and the Commissioners Court took it forward. Judge Garth was a visionary, who even took it a little further in terms of the scope of the facility, building not only livestock show facilities and exhibit halls but also an 8,000 seat performance arena where much of the Texas Hereford Junior State Show takes place today.

The facility opened in May of 1987. Over the last 27 years the facility has produced thousands of events of all different types. This past year, the Expo Center held 269 events which equated to 522 event days, with an attendance of 326,964. The Bell County Expo has added a great deal to the quality of life and economy of Bell County.

Two Texas Hereford Association members have been very active at the Bell County Expo Center. Bill Yowell of Killeen, served as the President of the Board of Directors for the Expo Center for many years and Curtis Younts has helped in coordinating the State Junior Show for several years and has provided valuable input as the future for the Expo Center is evaluated.

The planning process has already begun for expansion of the Expo Center, which would include a first class Equestrian/Livestock show facility, as well as updating of existing facilities including air-conditioning in the Exposition Building, preparing the way for more and larger shows in the future.

The Expo has a tenured staff with a great depth of experience in producing events. Customer service has always been paramount, which plays a big role in the success of the facility.

The Bell County Expo Center is proud to be the home for the Texas Hereford Junior State Show. ★

Jere, who is retired from farming and ranching, now enjoys watching his son Brady and grandsons Rhett and Ryan carry on and improve the herd he started. ★

Bill & Jessica McInnis

Bill and Jessica McInnis of May, Texas, have a long history of Hereford cattle in their blood. Their operation, McInnis Cattle Company, also has a unique history.

Located 12 miles North of Brownwood, Texas, McInnis Cattle Company traces its heritage back to 1857 when the original family settled on the banks of the Pecan Bayou. S.P. McInnis, Bill's great-grandfather, brought the first purebred Hereford cattle to Brown County Texas in 1873. A registered herd was then started in 1896, when S.P.'s son, Mitchell (Bud) Cox, bought 10 registered heifers from B.C. Rhome of Ft. Worth, Texas. Mitchell and his half brother, John McInnis, formed the Cox & McInnis partnership in 1902. Claude, John's son, started his own Polled Hereford herd in 1947. In 1973, Claude received the Texas Century Ranch designation made by the Family Land Heritage Program for 100 years of continuous land ownership and stewardship. In 2005, the American Hereford Association recognized

the McInnis family as a Century Hereford Breeder, one of twenty five such designations made that year nationally.

The name McInnis Cattle Company was officially born in 1969, when Bill and Claude formed their partnership. After graduating from Texas Tech University in 1965, Bill started a professional cattle fitting service and traveled across the nation exhibiting cattle. In 1973 he met Jessica Gearhart while showing bulls at the El Paso Bull Sale and the two were married the same year. Jessica was raised in the Davis Mountains, where her family had a stocker and cow/calf operation. Her great-grandfather, W.T. Jones, brought some of the first Herefords to West Texas. Her family was involved with the Highland Hereford Breeders until they moved to Brahman genetics in the 1970s.

Today McInnis Cattle Company is still a family operation. Bill and Jessica, along with their son Ben, and daughter-in-law Rachel, and two grandsons, Levi and Ty, comprise the fourth, fifth and sixth generations on this ranch. The cattle operation consists of 100 registered Horned and Polled Hereford cows and a herd of commercial blacks and black baldies. Artificial insemination plus embryo transfers utilizing the best genetics available nationwide are a large part of the constant search for improved production.

Bill and Ben handle the day-to-day operation, from cattle work to planting and harvesting crops, while Jessica maintains the cattle registrations, EPDs and book-keeping. Outside of ranching, Bill has served as director and member of the Executive Committee of the Texas Hereford Association and has had the privilege to serve as a judge and classifier at Texas shows. He is a member of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association and has been a tireless volunteer and supporter of the Brown County Fair and Rodeo for the past 50 years. Bill enjoys cooking for large crowds as has been evidenced at the Spring Gatherings hosted by the Texas Hereford Association the past several years. A

member of the Central United Methodist Church in Brownwood, Jessica enjoys singing in the choir and serves on the Board of Trustees. Jessica taught High School English and Spanish at May for many years but now is a full time grandmother. Rachel, Ben's wife, is a registered nurse in Brownwood, but with McInnis boy #3 on the way, she is about to have a very full schedule.

In 2014, Bill and Jessica, along with their children, decided to divide the farming and ranching operations. Ben chose to continue the historic ranch in Brown County as partner of McInnis Cattle Company, as well as operate the farms in Moore and Hutchison County as 96 Farm. Bill and Jessica's daughter and son-in-law, Rachel and Scott Myers, along with grandsons Brooks and Reece, now own and operate Jessica's New Mexico ranch and land in Armstrong County, Texas. They live in Claude, Texas.

Scott owns and operates Myers Cattle, a stocker cattle and a commercial cow/calf operation, while Rachel is Director of Insurance Services for AgTexas Farm Credit Services. As you can see, this family is firmly rooted in land and livestock.

"We are so thankful for the lifelong friendships we've built through the livestock industry. This year has been a challenge to our family and we have received great support through a very trying time. We love this way of life and are so proud that our children have chosen to remain in agriculture. 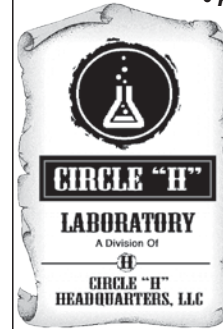
