Attention Juniors: \$4,500 for Top Jr. in 2017 Fort Worth National Show

Funds have been committed to award \$4,500 to the top placing junior heifer and \$2,500 to second place junior heifer that is exhibited at the National Hereford Show in Fort Worth. In addition a third and fourth scholarship of \$1,500 each will be awarded. Exhibitor must be at the halter of his/ her own heifer as well as be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week. To be eligible for the junior show, the ownership must be in only the exhibitors' name, no siblings or partners. See rule 12 on page 191 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book. The heifer must be eligible to show for Grand Champion (no Cow/ Calf). This is an incentive to encourage junior exhibitors to exhibit at the open show on January 30, 2017. To be eligible for the award, the exhibitor must enter the open show by the November 15th deadline. The exhibitor

must be a member of the Texas Junior Hereford Association.

The sponsors of this award are committed to making this an annual event and hope to grow the fund to increase the prize as well as create a special belt buckle for the event. Anyone wishing to join this effort should contact Jack Chastain at the THA office. *

am Massey was born into a long time ranching family in 1946. His grandfather established their ranch in Ward and Winkler counties, Texas in 1917 and raised commercial Herefords. Sam's first registered Hereford was a heifer purchased from Seth Campbell at Kermit, Texas.

Sam and wife Kila began their ranching operation in New Mexico after attending Sul Ross State College in Alpine, where Sam won several awards in livestock judging at the Houston Livestock Show.

Sam served as president of the New Mexico Junior Hereford Association, vice president of the New Mexico Hereford Association. He served president of the Southeastern New Mexico Hereford Association, The One Stop Hereford Association and the Southwestern New Mexico Hereford. He sold bulls and females at sales sponsored by all those organizations.

Kila was a founding member of the American Hereford Auxiliary.

In 1967 the Massey's hosted the New Mexico Junior Hereford field day, and in 1970 Sam coordinated the New Mexico State Hereford tour. Daughters Dena and Susan both served on the board of the New Mexico Junior Hereford Association and Dena served as New Mexico Junior Hereford queen.

Sam established the Zia Hereford bull performance test center in Lovington, New Mexico. After one year he moved it to the Wickett, Texas ranch and renamed it Lone Star Testing Center. It became one of the nations most prestigious Hereford performance test centers. The annual sale was honored as one of the top averages for consignment sales of its size by the American Hereford journal for many years.

Sam formed a Hereford partnership with Ricky Smith and Mayo Marrs of Kermit, Texas, the partnership of Marrs, Massey and Smith operated successfully for many years. During that time Sam served on the board of directors of the Sandhills Hereford and Quarter Horse Show in Odessa.

Sam then raised commercial cattle for several years and began a registered Braford herd. He served on the board of directors on the International Braford Association. He was instrumental in establishing the National Braford registry through the American Hereford Association.

Sam also formed a partnership with Earl McElroy in a sales management company, merchandising many Hereford cattle.

When Sam's grandchildren were old enough to show he bought Hereford show heifers for them to exhibit from many of the nations reputable breeders. His grandchildren, Garrett Floyd and Kim Wilson experienced a very successful show career throughout Texas and then nationwide. They won banners in Denver, Louisville, Reno, and Kansas City, as well as all of the major

Texas shows. Kim and Garrett exhibited Grand Champion Hereford and Polled Hereford heifers at Fort Worth Junior show four years in a row. Both grandkids were officers of the Texas Junior Hereford Association and Kim served as Texas Hereford Sweetheart as well as Queen.

In recent years, several Texas Junior Hereford members have experienced successful show careers with Sam and Kila's assistance.

Sam has served on the board of both the Texas Hereford Association and the Texas Polled Hereford Association. He is a board member of the Cross Timbers Hereford Association.


