James Walker, 91, passed away Jan. 26, 2017. He was born on Feb. 22, 1925, in Grapevine, TX, the oldest of seven children.

He graduated from Birdville High School in Haltom City in 1943 and served in the Merchant Marines during WWII and was honorably discharged in 1947. He attended North Texas State College, now known as The University of North Texas, where he received Bachelor of Science and Master of Science degrees.

While in college, he met his future wife Louise. They were married in 1954 and moved to Kilgore, TX after graduation. He taught school and coached football and basketball in Arp, TX.

Moving to Fort Worth in 1955, James began building houses and founded Walker Construction Company in 1963.

In the early 1960s he purchased land in Bosque County and founded the W4 Ranch. The ranch has grown into one of the largest registered Hereford operations in the country.
