

# Attention Juniors: \$4,500 for Top Jr. in 2020 Fort Worth National Show

THA Foundation has committed \$4,500 to the exhibitor of the highest placing heifer and \$2,500 to the second highest placing heifer at the 2020 Dudley Bros., Ltd. National Hereford Show in Fort Worth on February 3, 2020. A third and fourth place scholarship of \$1,500 will also be awarded. To be eligible to receive these awards, the exhibitor must be a member of TJHA, be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week (exhibitor does not have to exhibit at the junior show) and be at the halter of his/her heifer. No cow/calf is eligible. The ownership rules for the junior show must be met. See rule 10 on page 197 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book.

Friends of THA have sponsored the funds for this award for many years and are committed to making this an annual event and hope to grow the fund to increase the prize as well as create a special belt buckle for the event. #### **Kelly Henry Schmidt**

Kelly Henry Schmidt was born on August 14, 1923, at Schmidt Ranch in Mason County, TX, and passed away on November 11, 2019.

Kelly attended elementary school in Mason, then went to Peters Prairie School until eleventh grade, when he transferred to Mason High School. Upon graduating from Mason High School in 1941, Kelly became a member of the Texas A&M Corps of Cadets. He was eventually drafted into WWII and posted to France. Wounded in battle, Kelly was awarded the Purple Heart.

Kelly married Minnie Nell Gandy of Cameron, TX on June 18, 1949. They started a pedigreed Hereford herd and named the ranch "Schmidt Hereford Ranch," developing the business into a nationally recognized Hereford breeding program.

Kelly served on the boards of both the Texas Hereford Association and the Hill Country Hereford Association, and received many awards as a cattle judge and soil conservationist. He was awarded the Golden Breeder plaque by the AHA for 50 years in business.

Kelly and Minnie moved to Mason in 1996 and retired from ranching in 2008, turning the business over to son James Kelly and his wife Mona Lois Friday Schmidt.

Kelly is survived by his wife, Minnie Schmidt; son Steve Schmidt and daughter Shane Schmidt of Mason; son James Kelly Schmidt and wife Mona Lois Friday Schmidt of Mason and their children: Havana Mendoza and husband Capt. Richard Mendoza; Rio Kelly Schmidt; Monaco Hope Schmidt; and Texas Ranger Schmidt. Kelly is survived by several nieces and nephews. ★



#### **Gene Wiese**

Gene Wiese, 90, of Manning, Iowa born Aug. 31, 1929, passed away Nov. 14, 2019 in Manning.

Gene grew up east of Manning and attended school in Manning, graduating in 1947. He then went on to attend Iowa State University where he attained a degree in animal science and excelled as a member of the livestock dairy and meat judging team.

Gene married Jean Alice Warnke on Jan. 11, 1953. With the exception of a short time in Indianola, they made their home on their farm east of Manning. Gene and Jean were partners in Wiese and Sons Hereford Breeders. They traveled to numerous stock shows around the U.S., Europe, and Australia.

Gene was an avid member of First Presbyterian Church. He made a career out of his passion for agriculture and was a well-known environmental steward. He served as the president for the American Hereford, Iowa Cattlemen's and Iowa Hereford Associations. He held roles with the NCBA and Animal Trade Advisory Committee, supported various youth organizations such as 4-H and FFA, and judged numerous livestock shows on the local, state and national levels.

Gene was recognized with vari-

ous awards and inducted into the Iowa Hereford, Iowa Cattlemen's and American Hereford Halls of Fame.

Survivors include three children: Helen Wiese, Manning, David Wiese and wife Diana, Manning and Kathryn Wiese of Waimea, Hawaii; four grandchildren: Chancelor, Shayne and Trey Wiese, all of Manning, and Kieran Wiese Gibson, Hawaii; sister-inlaw Millicent Wiese, Manning; nieces: Barb, Mary and Nancy Wiese; and other relatives and friends. \*\*

#### Lloyd A. "Bill" Davis

Lloyd A. "Bill" Davis passed away November 15, 2019, at his home in the company of his loving family. Bill is survived by his beloved wife of over 70 years, Renate; sons Boris and Byron; grandchildren Jessica and Patrick; and caregivers Caroline and Hinda, and family friend Debbie Lehrmann.

Bill was born on May 31, 1927, to Thomas Davis and Bessie (Adams) Davis on the family farm close to Pachuta, Mississippi. Bill joined the Armed Forces after graduating high school. While serving in Berlin, Bill met and married Renate Blattner.

Bill and Renate returned to the United States, settling in Houston in 1947. Both Bill and Renate worked to put themselves through the University of Houston. Bill became a strong supporter of the University's Cougar Football, faithfully attending games for over 60 years.

While in Houston, Bill went to work for Metallic Building Company and worked through the ranks to become Vice-President and Treasurer until 1968. In 1969, Bill left his job with Metallic Building Co., and formed a new company, Engineered Components with partners Earl Vonderglotz and Jimmy Clift manufacturing metal building components.

The Davises crossbred cattle in Fayetteville from 1964 until Bill sold the farm in 1969. In 1971, Bill bought another farm in Bleiblerville, south of Brenham, and began raising Hereford Cattle. Bill expanded to about 600 acres of fine grazing property and grew his herd to 100 choice Herefords. Bill was an active member of the American Hereford Association, Texas Hereford Association and the Gulf Coast Hereford Association.

After 2010, Bill and Renate moved off the cattle operation into their Walnut Hill home in Brenham. Bill and Renate always had a passion for travel and were active travelers until their latter years. Bill was also a Master Mason for 67 years with the Walter M. Pierson Lodge #1339. ★

his loving and devoted daughter Robin. The family will continue working hard to make him proud and continue the legacy he worked so hard to build upon. OH TRIANGLE






Jack Chastain, Mineral Wells, TX, and Jim Reed, Green Ridge, MO, were inducted into the Hereford Hall of Merit during the American Hereford Association (AHA) Hereford Honorees awards ceremony during the AHA Annual Meeting and Conference, Oct. 25, in Kansas City, Mo.

The Hall of Merit award recognizes those who have played a vital role in shaping both the Hereford breed and the beef industry.

#### **Jack Chastain**

Jack Chastain known across the country as the face of the Texas Hereford Association (THA), he is considered the driving force behind the Hereford breed in the Southwest.

An admired ambassador of the breed, Jack began his storied career more than 50 years ago when he was named the executive secretary of the THA in 1973. He has spent his dynamic lifetime promoting and supporting Hereford producers at every level from purebred to commercial breeders to Certified Hereford Beef markets. His ability to effectively network with all segments of the industry has been a binding force as the THA continues to be a national leader in junior and senior memberships and registrations.

As many put it, when you think of the THA, you think of Jack. He has played a huge role in elevating the national Hereford show at the Fort Worth Stock Show and in building its prestige. The Texas membership meeting at the Fort Worth Stock Show is a true testament to the Chastain family's passion, enthusiasm and drive to better the THA and the breed.

Jack has traveled countless hours to sales and shows across the country to keep THA and AHA members at the forefront of the industry. In fact, when he first took office, he journeyed throughout the state to meet every producer in the THA membership to study each individual's herd. When not on the road, he can be found in the Fort Worth office organizing the THA magazine and striving to get new members for

the adult and junior associations.

Jack and his wife, Lyn, are recognized as some of the most generous and proactive youth supporters in the breed and are longstanding Texas Junior Hereford Association advisors. They have operated Mockingbird Hill Herefords since their marriage in 1975 and this year added their son, Lee, daughter-in-law, Candace, and their two grandsons, Jackson and Griffin, to the operation, now called Chastain Cattle Co. Their grandsons are the sixth generation to operate the land deeded to the Chastain family in 1853, which has been home to Hereford cattle since 1930.

Together, the family has built a legacy of Hereford cattle reaching far beyond their roots in Fort Worth. Their devotion to serving the membership and progressing the THA and the breed as a whole is unrivaled. Kyle and Michael Pérez of Pérez Cattle Co. note, "When Jack finally decides to retire, there will be a hole as large as Texas in the association that may never be totally filled. There has never been anyone more deserving and dedicated to this great breed."

#### **Jim Reed**

Born and raised as the fourth generation of his family to live in Green Ridge, Mo., Jim Reed and his wife, Linda, began raising Hereford cattle in 1962. For the last 44 years, Reed Enterprises has been the operation's genetic marketing arm by providing semen and AI certificates. The couple also operates Midwest Cattle Service and Reed Farms.

At the request of Mark Dempsey with the Missouri Ruralist, Jim worked his first sale as a college student for Harry and Hal Nichols in 1963. From that moment, he was forever hooked as a ringman.

Jim came on board as the Beef Superintendent for the Missouri State Fair in 1972, where he dedicated 17 years to serving fairgoers and the beef industry. One of his most memorable moments was President Ronald Reagan's visit to the

fair, where Reagan's secret service took over the beef cattle office. Another iconic moment was the fair's 1974 Hereford show, which featured 411 head of polled Herefords and more than 100 head of horned Herefords. Jim now serves on the Missouri State Fair Foundation board of directors, where he remains dedicated to cultivating the next generation of agriculture through preservation, education and improvement initiatives.

In partnership with close friend Bill Maerli of Owensville, Mo., Jim and Linda formed Midwest Cattle Service in 1975 to manage polled Hereford and Simmental sales throughout the U.S. Although Bill left to pursue other interests, Jim and Linda continued to grow the business as a husband-and-wife team and have helped market millions of dollars' worth of Hereford genetics over the last 57 years. Jim has worked with breeders to hold successful production and consignment sales, has organized small groups of breeders to host joint sales, and has screened cattle and has managed major sales throughout the country.

Jim has been a trustworthy source for information and trends across the breed and continues to serve as a consultant and ringman at sales nationwide while producing and promoting Hereford genetics everywhere he goes.

"Jim is a true influencer of the breed," says Marty Lueck, manager of Journagan Ranch of Missouri State University. "Jim and Linda have supported our Hereford breed for a lifetime. They continue to be a catalyst for the Hereford breed and our breeders' programs."

# Jarrett Worrell Wins Award in NJHA Fed Steer Shootout Contest

For three years running, the National Junior Hereford Association (NJHA) has brought real-world experience and education to its junior membership. In 2019, 67 youth from 15 states entered 206 steers in the NJHA Fed Steer Shootout contest, powered by BioZyme Inc. and the Feed the Future program. This year's NJHA contest winners were recognized for their efforts Oct. 25 at the Hereford Honorees awards ceremony in Kansas City, Mo., and received close to \$20,000 in awards from the Hereford Youth Foundation of America (HYFA) and BioZyme.

Contestants collected actual feedyard performance and carcass merit data on pens and individual entries of Hereford and Hereford-influenced steers while gaining a comprehensive industry education on topics such as ultrasound technology, genetics and cattle health. All steers were fed at Gregory Feedlots in Tabor, IA, and through a generous sponsorship from Texas Stardance Cattle, steers were hauled to and harvested at National Beef Packing Co. in Dodge City, KS, as candidates for the Certified Hereford Beef® brand.

"The NJHA Fed Steer Shootout proved to be yet another successful year for the participants and I would like to congratulate all of the winners on their accomplishments," says Trey Befort, American Hereford Association (AHA) director of commercial programs. "I am proud of all of the youth who have taken the initiative to participate in this contest and look forward to watching this program grow and develop in the years to come."

Participation nearly doubled from the previous year and so did BioZyme's financial commitment and quest to bring education to the forefront of the contest. Contestants entered performance portfolios from data reports they received throughout the feeding period and wrote an essay about what they learned from the process. The top five participants were selected from the submitted portfolios, and had the opportunity to travel to Kansas City, Mo., to compete for the NJHA Fed Steer Shootout Junior of the Year title during the AHA Annual Membership Meeting and Conference. These juniors presented a short speech and were interviewed about what they learned from the contest and how they can apply this knowledge in the beef industry.




