# Spring 2020 Platinum and Gold TPR Breeders Announced

The AHA is excited to debut the Platinum TPR<sup>TM</sup> (Total Performance Records) Breeder awards in spring 2020. Ten Hereford breeders achieved this tremendous status.

The Platinum TPR program was established in 2018 to recognize breeders who participate in the Association's Whole Herd Total Performance Records (TPR<sup>TM</sup>) program that was implemented in 2001 to create a more accurate database and increase the value of

Hereford genetics. The Platinum TPR Breeder is the highest level of achievement when it comes to complete calf crop reporting. Breeders must meet all of the requirements of Gold TPR Breeder status plus genotype 85% of their calves with a weaning weight submitted

The Platinum and Gold TPR Breeder awards are designated two times a year and are awarded each calving season. The selection of Platinum and Gold TPR breeders takes place during the process of loading each new run of expected progeny differences in January (spring) and July (fall). The criteria for Platinum and Gold TPR breeders will be evaluated two years prior to the award year. The following spring 2020 TPR awards reflect the spring 2018 calving season evaluation.

Ninety-three Hereford breeders achieved Gold TPR<sup>TM</sup> (Total Performance Records) status for spring 2020.

Established in 2005, the program pays tribute to breeders who go the extra mile to collect data at all levels of production and report the data in a timely manner. The Gold TPR Breeder recognition is presented to progressive Hereford breeders who have measured traits and collected and promptly submitted performance data at all levels of production.

Congratulations to these Texas Hereford Association members and Texas breeders. Platinum TPR breeders include Express Ranches, Yukon, OK and Flying S Herefords, Paluxy. Gold TPR breeders include Colyer Herefords, Bruneau, ID; Copeland & Sons, LLC, Nara Visa, NM; Indian Mound Ranch, Canadian; Powell Ranches, San Angelo; Ledbetter Cattle Co., Wheeler; P&J Polled Herefords, La Vernia; Texas 2T Farm, Nacogdoches; Texas Stardance Cattle, LLC, Hamilton; Willis Polled Herefords, Emory. ★



n a recent Saturday, my friend told me he'd found the best burger in Fort Worth at a place called Hookers Grill. So I splashed on some Old Spice, jumped in the truck, and high-tailed it to the stockyards. But Hookers Grill isn't what the name suggests. In fact, this small outdoor restaurant is the perfect place to bring the whole family.

Located on Exchange St. just a few blocks west of Main, Hookers Grill is an inviting space with brightly colored picnic tables, hand painted murals, string lights, and classic country music playing on the radio. A decent crowd of families, couples, and friends was already enjoying lunch when we arrived.

In the middle of the yard there is a partially enclosed heated dining area with roof-top seating and behind that, a small building that houses the kitchen and ordering windows. The menu offers standard grill fare such as patty melts and hotdogs as well as more unique options like indian tacos, fried bologna sandwiches, loaded tater tots, and peanut butter milkshakes. But the house specialty is the famous fried onion burger made with Certified Hereford Beef.

What exactly is a fried onion burger? For starters, it's delicious, and if

you've never had one, it's a must try. Invented in El Reno, Oklahoma in the 1900's, the patty is cooked on a griddle or flat top with a generous handful of chopped raw onion pressed into the meat. My friend ordered a double with cheese and topped it with an egg and green chili gravy. I opted for the same, but chose continued on page 37

the traditional toppings of pickles and mustard.

Our names were called and we were handed two giant, paper-wrapped burgers. The buns were well toasted with a nice buttery crunch. The Certified Hereford Beef patties were huge, well seasoned, and full of delicious griddle-fried onions and melted cheese. The addition of the green chili gravy, which is really more of a thick, warm salsa boasting citrus notes balanced by cumin and spices, was a homerun. It pairs perfectly with the caramelization imparted by the griddle. These burgers are delicious and greasy, so don't forget to ask for extra napkins. You'll need them.

One of the highlights of our visit was Ms. Kathryn Hooker, mother of the owner, Ruth Hooker. Ms. Kathryn is all smiles while working the order window. She's quick to answer questions and offers great recommendations. When I asked why Hookers Grill chose to serve Certified Hereford Beef, she proudly shared some family history. Before moving to Fort Worth, the Hookers raised Hereford cattle on their ranch in Oklahoma, so when it came time to choose beef for their restaurant, they wanted to go with the best. "People say it's a great tasting burger. They love meat."




