

Attention Juniors: \$4,000 for Top Jr. in 2023 Fort Worth National Show

THA Foundation has committed \$4,000 to the exhibitor of the highest placing heifer and \$2,500 to the second highest placing heifer at the 2023 Jack and Lyn Chastain National Hereford Show in Fort Worth on January 30, 2022. A third-place scholarship of \$1,000, and fourth place scholarship of \$500 will also be awarded. To be eligible to receive these awards, the exhibitor must be a member of TJHA, be eligible to show in the junior show the previous week (exhibitor does not have to exhibit at the junior show) and be at the halter of his/her heifer. No cow/calf is eligible. The ownership rules for the junior show must be met. See rule 10 on page 146 of the Fort Worth Stock Show premium book.

Friends of THA have sponsored the funds for this award for many years and are committed to making this an annual event and hope to grow the fund to increase the prize. Anyone wishing to join this effort should contact Jack Chastain at the THA office. *


Against Drought

othing can undo the misery caused by continued drought and having to sell productive cows. It has been a too-common practice in 2022. But with the federal pasture, rangeland, forage (PRF) insurance program, producers can hedge against the lack of rainfall and receive government payments to help buy replacements or supplemental feed.

That was one message received by ranchers and others who attended the annual School for Successful Ranching presented by the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association at its annual convention this spring in Fort Worth.

With the Southwest stuck in a disastrous drought, producers have been forced to either thin herds or provide supplemental forage and other feed to maintain them. School sessions touched on ways to improve production and financial efficiency through better grazing management,

nutrition, price risk management and other methods of reducing losses.

The PRF program was among the risk management tools that caught a lot of interest. Austin Tucker of Specialized Crop Insurance presented the PRF session. His territory covers much of the Southwest.

The program is formally called the Rainfall Index for Pasture, Rangeland and Forage (RI-PRF) under the USDA Risk Management Agency's catalog of risk management services. It was the result of 2014 legislation by U.S. Rep. Frank Lucas of western Oklahoma, an area that's seen more than its share of parched pastures.

Tucker said PRF provides livestock producers and forage producers with

a tool to mitigate drought risk. It differs from crop insurance products for traditional crops. "It's based on rainfall indexes that are calculated using precipitation measured over two-month intervals and compared to historical data within a specified grid area," he said. "When the average historical rainfall is less than the guaranteed amount for the insured area, the insured producer is paid an indemnity based on the difference between the two."

La Niña Nightmare

PRF is helping producers wake up from the drought nightmare caused by the La Niña weather pattern. La Niña has kept the Southwest dry and the Midwest wet. It was forecast nearly a year ago, based on data from the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration (NOAA).

The forecast was accurate. More than half of Texas was under extreme drought as late as mid-May. Had the region's ranchers used PRF insurance to cover deficit precipitation, they could likely have collected an indemnity.

PRF coverage is based on grids set by NOAA. Each grid is 0.25 degrees in latitude by 0.25 degrees in longitude at the equator, which equals about 12 by 12 miles in the U.S. PRF policies are based on two-month periods or index intervals: January-February, February-March, March-April, April-May, May-June, June-July, July-August, August-September, September-October, October-November and November-December.

Policyholders must select at least two, two-month periods. They have the option to


buy up to six. Selection is typically based on when precipitation is most important to an operation. To help reduce costs of the coverage, USDA will pay 51 percent or more of the premium.

Insurance payments are determined by using NOAA data for the grids and index intervals covered by a policy. Thousands of individual weather stations provide grid precipitation data. When the final grid index falls below their "trigger grid index," Tucker said the policyholder may receive an indemnity automatically. Payment typically takes 45 to 60 days after the interval.

"There is no claim or production to turn in. Coverage is based on the experience of the entire grid," he said. "It's not based on individual farms, ranches or specific weather stations in the general area. Everything is based off of the NOAA data, not your rainfall or production."

the 2022 range and forage coverage must have been purchased before Dec. 1, 2021. Sign up is through a licensed RMA insurance provider, who likely also features other RMA crop insurance programs.

The typical sign-up period is Sept. 1 through Dec. 1 for 2023. "Technically you can sign up when you want," Tucker said. "But it doesn't make sense to sign up until after Aug. 31. That's the contract change date deadline from USDA. They can change rates and production value of the land up until then."

Coverage levels are based on the amount of protection sought. Coverage levels are 70 percent, 75 percent, 80 percent, 85 percent and 90 percent. Like with any type of insurance policy, the higher percentage levels cost more.

Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Economist Justin Benavidez encourages producers to consider PRF. Based in Amarillo, he sees how drought has impacted Southern Plains ranchers. As an example of PRF coverage, he cited a ranching area in Hardeman County in northwest Texas, where forage production is critical. He used USDA-RMA's PRF Support Tool to calculate coverage levels (see table).

"For our example, we're using a coverage level of 90 percent and a productivity factor of 100 percent," Benavidez said. "Moreover, we are going to use results from the 2011 year (a terrible drought year) as the sample year, but with 2022 prices."

The strategy was to insure months

in which forage production is vital for the ranch operation. He chose to insure 30 percent for the interval May-June, 40 percent July-August, and 30 percent September-October.

The USDA support tool estimated the producer premium at \$2.20 per acre for the 1,000 acres ranch example. "The estimated indemnity was calculated as \$17.07 per acre," Benavidez said, "resulting in \$14.87 after premium cost.

"Assuming a stocking rate of 15 acres per cow, the net result obtained per cow was \$223.05. These indemnities might not be enough to cover all the extra costs and hard work during a severe drought, but they will certainly help pay for most of our additional feeding costs."

Benavidez also analyzed the impact of this strategy over the last 20 years. The support tool estimated average a payment of \$1.74 per acre for those 20 years above premium costs. The coverage would have paid off most of the time.

"In five of the 20 years, indemnities were not high enough to compensate for premiums paid," he said. "In 75 percent of the cases, the program paid indemnities to cover producers' premium costs given this grid location. Most importantly, it supported producers to cover extra and higher feeding costs when precipitation is lower than usual."

With drought more common than wet weather in much of Texas, Tucker said producers could nearly always recover their premium costs and often receive enough payments to help buy replacements or feed.

"Every one of my Texas customers has earned a payment in the 2022 crop year," he said.

In the end, no farmer or rancher can determine when and if it will rain. Pastures are at the mercy of Mother Nature. But PRF insurance is a tool to help offset poor grazing conditions. It's a way for desperate producers to help fool Mother Nature – and hedge against a drought.






