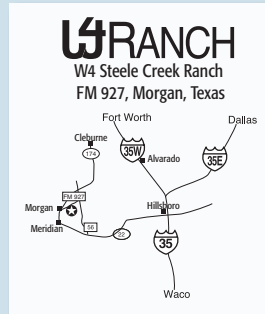

## Frequently Asked Questions



### What is the Texas Hereford Winter Classic?

The Texas Hereford Winter Classic is a premier winter cattle show hosted by the Texas Hereford Association. It brings together Hereford enthusiasts from across the region for a weekend of friendly competition, tradition, and holiday spirit. The show includes Junior and Open divisions, Miniature Hereford classes, and festive extras like Cowboy Santa and a cornhole tournament.

### Do we have to be a Texas Hereford Association member to enter?

No, Texas Hereford Association membership is not required to enter the show.

### How do I enter?

All entries must be submitted through Showman.app. The direct link will be available on the Texas Hereford Association website and shared via social media as the entry window opens.

### When do barns open for arrival?

Barns open for early equipment move-in on Wednesday, December 3. Regular cattle move-in will begin on Thursday, December 4, and continue through Friday, December 5.

### Should I bring my own bedding or will it be available to purchase on the grounds?

Bedding must be purchased on site. Both flake and pellet shavings will be available for purchase at the facility.

### What are the health requirements for this show?

Yes, current health papers are required for all breeding animals, as the show is open to out-of-state cattle. For more details, please visit showman.app.

### Is this show fitted?

The Open Show will be fitted, allowing full grooming and fitting techniques. The Junior Show will be Blow and Go, with no adhesive or fitting products permitted.

### Can I bring a generator?

Yes, generators are allowed and even encouraged.

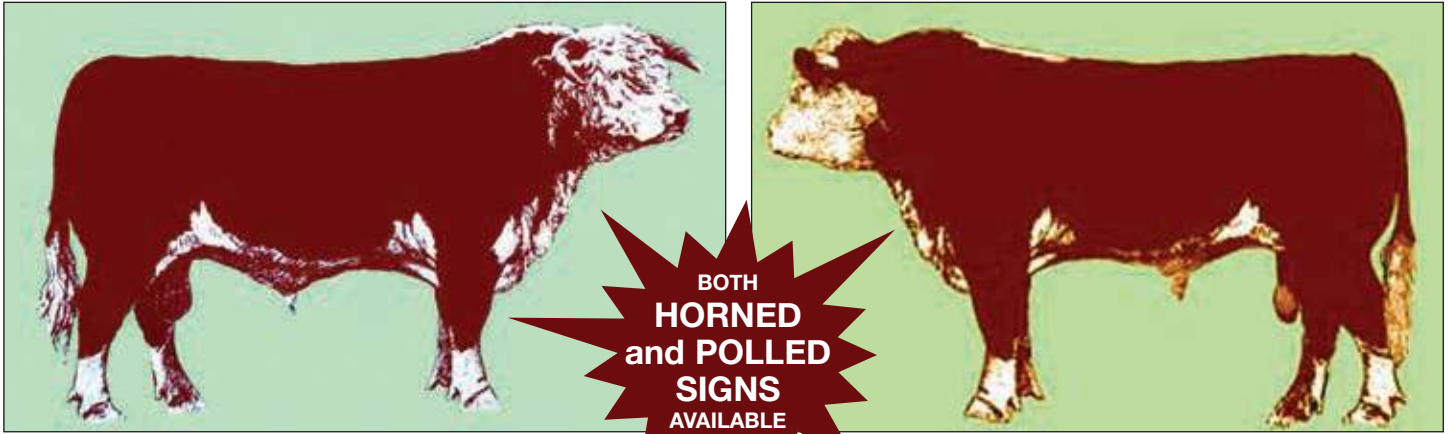

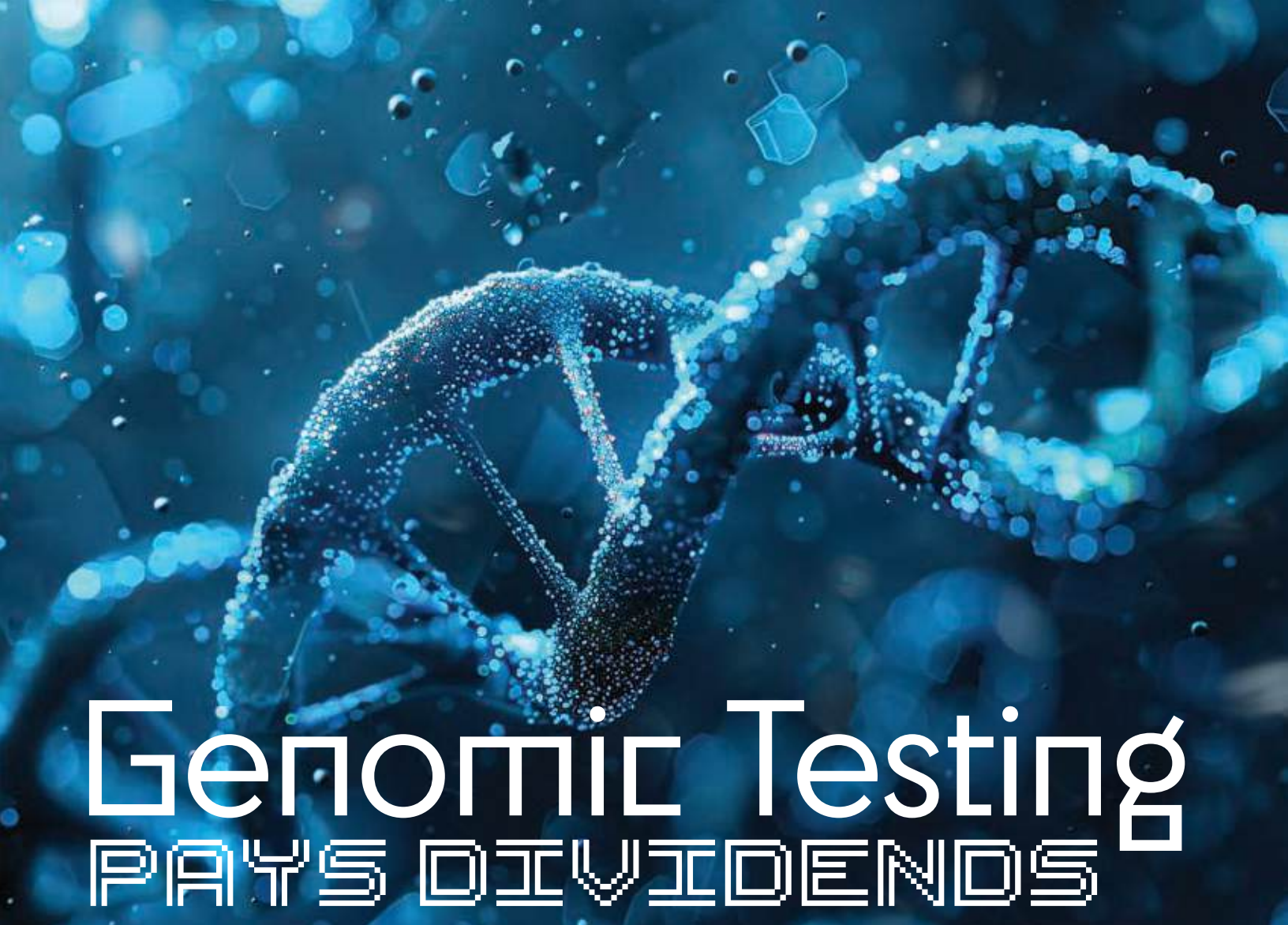

# Genomic Testing PAYS DIVIDENDS

ata driven decisions are invaluable to beef producers as they seek to reach peak performance for their herd, combined with the most financially favorable outcomes.

Genomic testing is one way that producers can confidently use data to make genetic progress within their herd and help see positive impacts to their bottom line.

“Over the years, commercial cattle producers have only had visual appearance and individual measurements, known as phenotypes, to use for heifer selection criteria. Now producers can evaluate the genetic differences between heifers well before their first potential breeding season. Having genomic test results for economically important traits, while selecting potential replacements, allows producers to estimate potential heifer productivity before going through a breeding season or calving,” said Jason Duggin, University of Georgia Beef Specialist.

With genomic testing, for both purebred bulls and females, producers can make more informed decisions on heifer selection, culling, and matings with more assurance and see results with fewer calving cycles!

Duggin continued, “Genomic testing also adds value to young, registered bulls by improving EPD (expected progeny difference) accuracies. Bulls with genomically enhanced EPDs will have similar information as compared to bulls that have already sired seven or more reported calves, depending on the trait. Buyers can have even greater assurance in the EPD reported traits they are seeking to improve in their herds when they are genomically enhanced.”

## Background

There are primarily two companies that offer genetic testing, Neogen and Zoetis. For producers who wish to

conduct genetic testing on their females and/or bull, either a blood sample or tissue sample will be collected by the producer. Blood samples are submitted on specific blood cards that can be purchased through the company that will perform the test. Tissue samples are collected using the TSU (tissue sampling unit) kits offered through Allflex. These are collected using a TSU sampling unit also available through Allflex.

For those wanting to test purebred animals for genomically enhanced EPDs, samples will be submitted through the respective breed association. Test for commercial cattle will be submitted directly to your preferred lab such as Zoetis or Neogen. Before samples are collected, it is recommended to contact the lab or breed association to prevent issues with submission and results.

After being shipped off, results will be provided usually six weeks later. Producers will receive information at least 16 traits such as stayability, weaning and yearling weight, ribeye area, marbling, milk, heifer pregnancy and more.

For commercial cattlemen, who don't have access to EPDs for their females, and possibly their bulls, this genetic testing can help make data driven decisions when it comes to mating decisions and female selection. In fact, commercial heifer testing is rapidly growing in popularity and use.

## How to Use the Scores

The scores are easy to read – usually set on a scale of 1-10. with the higher number indicating a more favorable score – and the company used for testing will have a tool

that allows producer's to build a database with the information received.

Duggin shared that, "Genomic scores are much like EPDs in their use. Producers can focus on the indexes that combine several traits or a few individual traits that are

of greatest concern. Producers can set their own criteria for their operation's specific needs and goals. Cattlemen wanting to enhance carcass merit in their herd can select against those cattle that are in the bottom."

## Why It Matters

"Using genomic testing, along with good nutrition and reproductive management, can benefit producers by improving the odds of retaining heifers that will stay in the herd longer. Testing is another tool in our toolbox. If you test 50 heifers at three months of age and decide then that you want to develop a handful of them, that can save you several thousand dollars in development costs and save you in the long run as you cull females who won't have the longevity needed to turn a profit," Duggin continued, "Each female that is culled during the first five years of production is a net loss when factoring annual cow cost with development or purchase cost. In short, genomic scores for commercial heifers can be used to improve confidence in selection decisions which can reduce development cost with faster genetic improvement in targeted traits."

Dr. Troy Rowan, assistant professor and beef genetics extension specialist at the University of Tennessee, recommends that producers test more females than they plan to keep, "not just the ten you planned on retaining already," he said. In doing so, you can confirm the decision you were already making or make adjustments.

He went on to say that having these genomic tests will prove beneficial when

marketing cattle. “You can open doors when it is time to market your cattle based on their genetic potential. This is true for the females that you test or their offspring (as you can promote the dam and/or sire’s genetic potential),” Rowan shared.

“EPDs coupled with genomic testing is not perfect, but is more accurate and a better tool than EPDs without genomic testing...”

For seedstock bulls, even those with EPDs, the benefit of a genetic test is the increased assurance and confidence in his genetic makeup. For any commercial cattleman using an unproven bull, genomic testing can provide increased confidence in his EPDs. This knowledge can help determine if he will become your herd sire or not. For bulls with EPDs, genomic testing is still recommended to determine and increase the accuracy of his EPDs.

Rowan shared that “Genomic testing is our way of directly seeing which chunks of DNA are inherited from parents. In doing so, we are better able to understand relationships between traits and increase accuracy on unproven, young animals. This allows producers to better predict the genetic potential of the animal. This is particularly important when buying bulls as one bull will be bred to several females and have the biggest impact on your herd.”

Rowan added that, “EPDs coupled with genomic testing is not perfect, but is more accurate and a better tool than EPDs without genomic testing...and EPDs without genomic testing is better than visual selection only.”

“The big benefit is that it makes EPDs and selection indexes more accurate and more confident. You will never see an increase of accuracy in EPDs for your bulls (or females) without the addition of genetic testing. A test is essentially equal to one calf crop (20-40 calves) of data. There is no downside to having your herd bulls genomically tested,” Rowan continued, “Even if the EPDs on your bulls (or females) shifts unfavorably, it’s still better to test because it gets you closer to the truth and gives you a better representation of what will be passed to offspring and the potential of your calf crop.”

The data from testing is only useful if it is put into practice and used to make decisions for your operation. With genomic testing results, producers can confidently and much more easily determine the next steps for their herd and be that much closer to raising even higher quality cattle! ★

LJ was also a member of the St. Joseph’s Catholic Church in Dilley, and he was a faithful Catholic until the very end.

In 1973, he married Helen Smith, and they remained true and loving companions until her death in November 2019. During their marriage they traveled extensively, primarily in the summer when Helen was not teaching. Their travels included most European countries, Russia, and the Patagonia area of Chile as well as the continental U.S. Louie taught Helen much about his cattle business-registered Herefords and she accompanied him several times to his semi-annual trips to the world class bull auctions in Montana. He is an Honorary Member of the Texas Hereford Association.

LJ is survived by a sister, Margaret Ann (Craig) Siegfried of Pennsylvania; brother-in-law Milton Tater of Inez; and sister-in-laws: Francis Carroll of Dilley, Mary Jo Phillips of Pearsall and Cynthia Smith of Houston

Today, Express Ranches is the largest seedstock cattle operation in the United States. Bob was proud of the outstanding team at the Ranch, led by his dear friend, the late Jarold Callahan.

Bob founded the Express Ranches Progressive Junior Scholarship Program 30 years ago, through which he donated \$5 million in scholarships, helping more than 500 students graduate from college.

Bob is lovingly survived by his family: son Bob Funk, Jr. and his wife Kim Garrett-Funk, his daughter Julie Bridges and her husband Chris Bridges, his beloved grandchildren, Bailey Morgan and her husband Tyler,

He is also survived by his companion, Janine.

# summer veggie fave

Summer heat and our vegetable garden has exploded. With all the rains this past spring and summer, the grass is green, hay cuttings have been better than good, and my husband and I like many of you should be zucchini and pepper farmers!

My husband compares his garden to dear friend Mary Barber's and they swap pictures of their tomatoes and garden plots all summer by messages. We chose to do raised beds this year compared to Mary's beautiful large garden in the ground like we've always done, and we may never go back. The weeding definitely easier and watering a snap.

My favorite thing when it comes to cooking in the summer is the limited trips to the grocery store because of our garden veggies. We never get tired of tomatoes and cucumbers on a plate as a side every night. And what we can't eat, I'm big on freezing for winter months when I'll serve stewed tomatoes by a roast beef with the local purple hull peas I put up from local farms. And our Hereford beef is somehow always incorporated in with all that garden haul that sits on my counters overflowing from trays.

The recipe I share with you this month is a simple one, and oldie but goodie. Makes the kids eat their veggies and is a super healthy, low calorie meal. ★

## Veggie Lasagna

### INGREDIENTS

- 2 pound(s) ground beef or pork, cooked and crumbled fine
- 2 yellow squash, sliced in 1 by 4 inch slivers
- 2 zucchini, sliced in 1 inch by 6 inch slivers
- 2 eggplant, peeled and cut in to 1 inch by 4 inch slivers (slices)
- 1 can(s) Spaghetti Sauce (I used Hunt's 4 Cheese variety)
- 1 can(s) Rotel Tomatoes with Cilantro and Lime Juice
- 2 teaspoon(s) Italian seasoning
- 1 teaspoon(s) Slap Your Mamma Seasoning or any Cajun Seasoning or Tony Chachere
- 2 cup(s) cheddar or any grated cheese of your choice (I used a Colby Jack mixed cheese)
- 1/2 cup(s) Parmesan cheese, grated

### INSTRUCTIONS

- Slice and prepare all vegetables and layer in a 9 x 13 inch Pyrex dish or long rectangular cooking dish. I slice them long into to this ribbons about 1/2 inch thick
- In a pan, cook beef. Drain excess fat and add spaghetti sauce and blend well. Heat through until bubbly.
- While this meat begin your layers in a 9 x 13 inch Pyrex or lasagna pan seasoning well with a Cajun season like Tony Chachere's with every layer and sprinkle of Italian Seasoning. A little goes a long, long way!
- Add 2 cups of cheddar cheese over top of the vegetables.
- Add one can of Rotel Tomatoes with Cilantro and Lime over the top of the cheese.
- Add meat with spaghetti sauce or just the sauce if making this vegetarian on top of cheese and vegetables. Layer in this same way again until the second layer has your meat sauce on top.
- Cook in the oven at 375 degrees covered with foil for approximately 1 hour. When you are able to see the dish bubble on the sides and when you can fork through the center easily of the vegetable lasagna, your dish is cooked.
- Take out of the oven and sprinkle with Parmesan cheese.
- Return to the oven and allow to cook for five more minutes.
- Before cutting into sections, allow the lasagna to cool and thereby sit to set up and it will come out easier.

Serve and enjoy!

*Meal suggestions: Serve my marinated cucumbers, Zucchini Squares, and Pasta Salad all from my The Ranch Kitchen along with crusty French bread alongside this dish.*

\*\*\* To make this a vegetarian dish, do not add in the ground beef or pork. You can also make this lower in sugar by using the new lower-sugar varieties of spaghetti sauce that are popular right now.

*Note: I did not add cubed onions and garlic to the meat as it cooked, but that would be a great addition.*

## Alise's Easy Fried Squash or Eggplant

### INGREDIENTS

- 3 squash, 3 zucchini, or one large oblong eggplant
- 1-2 packages of cornbread mix or fish fry cornbread mix if your choice. I like Pioneer's brand of instant cornbread mixes.
- Add in one teaspoon of Tony Chacheres Creole Seasoning and garlic salt into mix and stir well.

### INSTRUCTIONS

- \*\*\*For frying eggplant:
- Peel eggplant and salt on both side. Set on a platter with paper towels under and on top of them and allow them to sweat out the bitter juices with a large heavy dish on top of it for fifteen minutes or ore. Drain well by washing with water and set aside.
- For all veggies: Slice each squash, zucchini, or eggplant into 1/2 inch rounds.
- Wet and drain veggies with water, and place in a bowl with the cornbread mix. Push veggies into the mix on both sides and round edges. Fry in one inch of oil. Turn with a fork and cook on both sides until browned.
- Place on a paper towel lined tray and sprinkle lightly with garlic salt, and serve hot.

My husband Scott could eat the entire tray!

\*\*\*Y'all notice that I did not use an egg wash and promise it doesn't need it!

These fried garden vegetables are perfect with the veggie lasagna.

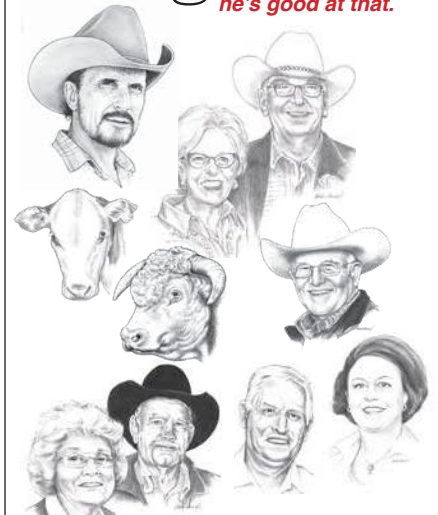

Beau advanced the Certified Hereford Beef® brand, helped unify the Horned and Polled Hereford organizations, supported growing youth programs, and expanded the AHA's international footprint especially in Latin America and Australasia.

Beau married Kathleen Harnett in 1993. They settled in a ranch house on the Chispa Ranch. Within a few years, however, Kathleen received a series of senior political appointments in Austin so Beau and Kathleen found a farmhouse in Rosanky and suitable for their growing hobby of raising Jack Russell Terriers.

Beau was predeceased by his beloved Kathleen who died in 2024. He is also predeceased by his mother in 2010 and his father in 2013. He is survived by his adopted son, Geoff Connor, of Bastrop. He is also survived by his younger brother, McMinn (Mac) White and his wife Julie of Marfa.

A memorial service was held on July 3 in Bastrop. ★
